#### ... but excludes other ticketed events:

- Overseas performances (e.g. Hong Kong Arts Festival)
- Commercial hires (e.g. Snowman concert) where we might get no data at all
- · Community concerts
- Wizard of Oz film screening with live orchestra not really a concert – how is this classified?
- Pre-performance talks (free)
- Dress rehearsals (free)
- Special events (e.g. Opera Insights) (free)
- Schools concerts

## Questions / issues to resolve

- Spreadsheet would have to be huge 31 venues for us this year
- Absence of data from most venues (e.g. subscriptions, % of tickets sold online)
- Subscriptions available on mainscale opera (venue-by-venue, apart from MK/OX) and also at ICS concerts at St David's Hall
- Are we measuring what matters (e.g. % of tickets sold online)?
- What else should we measure? Percentage attendance (including or excluding comps?)
- Different currencies how do we compare like with like? Are we reporting Gross or Net?
- Our financial year runs September to August do we all need to report the same financial year?
- Average ticket prices vary hugely from family concerts to mainscale opera

  – does this matter?
- Venue capacities from 210 to 2,300 does this matter?
