

Dress code

It is a Wexford Festival Opera tradition that evening dress is recommended for those attending performances. In practice, the custom may be interpreted fairly liberally. We would advise delegates to incline towards more formal than casual dress for the evening occasions.

Travel

Dublin airport is served by many international airlines. Wexford Festival Opera is arranging for bus transfers to all 3 hotels leaving the airport on Monday 28 October at 11.00, 12.00, 13.00 and 15.00. Buses will also leave the hotels Thursday 31 October to bring participants back to Dublin airport at 5.00, 7.00 and 9.00. The journey takes approximately 2 hours.
